Bark River delivered the kind of weekend that tests every racer's heart, horsepower, and grit. Mother Nature threw the first punch, with Saturday's races completely rained out, meaning Sunday became an all-out, double-header brawl for Rounds 11 and 12.



ROUND 11

SUNDAY MORNING THRILLS

PRO LITE:

Johnny came out swinging from a P3 start, seizing the lead and controlling the pace into the competition caution. The heat turned up in the second half, where contact forced a stop-and-go to be served that dropped Johnny to the back with less than two minutes to go. But if you know Johnny, you know the fight was far from over. With relentless drive, Johnny hunted down the leaders, storming past 4th and 3rd on the final lap to snatch a podium finish.



PRO2:

From the drop of the green flag, Johnny was in the mix for the top spot. The race was wheel-to-wheel until a flipped truck brought out the caution, setting up a sprint to the finish. Johnny held P3 on the restart and went door-to-door with the leaders in a fiberglass-flying battle all the way to the checkered flag, locking in another hard-fought podium.







ROUND 12: AFTERNOON SHOWDOWN

PRO LITE:

Starting as the top qualifier, Johnny wasted no time muscling his way towards the front. A shredded right-rear tire forced him to the hot pit, but Johnny was able to stay on the lead lap thanks to the competition caution. On the restart, he charged from 4th to 2nd with a precision slide job that had fans roaring. He closed in on the leader, but the laps ran out.



PRO 2:

Starting P2, Johnny took Bark River's infamous roost head-on as he tracked down the lead. The first half of the race was a non-stop battle for 2nd, 3rd, and 4th, with Johnny edging out P3 by just .02 seconds heading into the competition caution. Quickly getting back up to P2, Johnny hounded the leader setting a blistering pace, while looking for an opening. But the checkered flag came too soon, and Johnny secured another podium.





WEEKEND RESULTS:

Four races. Four podiums. One relentless drive to keep pushing the limits. Bark River proved once again, it's not about winning; its about showing up, fighting hard, and leaving it all on the track.
