PRO LITE

Saturday:

Saturday's showdown started with Johnny launching from P2 and sending it into Turn 1, sliding perfectly into the lead, and holding it for the first half of the race. But off-road racing never gives it easy. Coming out of the competition caution, Turn 1 threw a curveball, lifting Johnny up on the bicycle and cracking the door open for the pack. But Johnny's never die attitude kicked in, as he fired off the fastest lap of the race, a scorching 57.373 seconds, took back the lead, and never looked back. That checkered flag marked his seventh win in the Pro Lite division this season, and it felt right at home.





Sunday:

Sunday brought chaos. The battle for the lead was intense and Johnny was forced into the hot pits right before the comp caution after catching a shredded tire and would require a restart at the back of the pack. But fans know, never count out #44. The comeback was in motion until a tight turn and a squeeze between two trucks ended with the Pro Lite on its side. Johnny was able to get the truck back on all fours, but time wasn't on his side. Johnny still battled his way to a P6 finish, a gritty drive that showed heart, hustle, and zero quit.

Saturday in Pro 2, Johnny came out swinging, top qualifier and rolling off from P2. But staying up front didn't mean staying clean. Contact came early and often, with elbows up and bumpers out in every corner. Right before the comp caution, a trip to the hot pits knocked Johnny to the back of the pack. Sunday's Pro 2 race didn't hold the same fortune. Starting P7, Johnny had his eyes set on another signature charge, but mechanical gremlins cut the run short before he could even unleash the beast.
